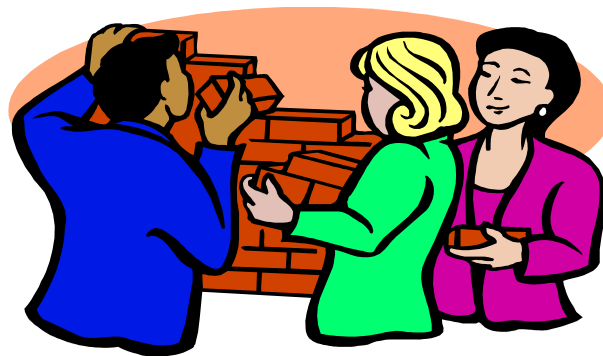

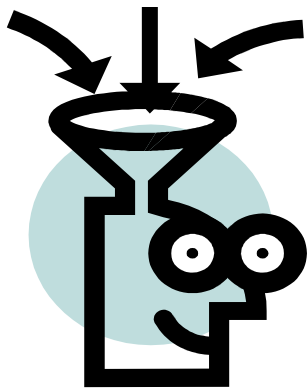


Teams – How We Are Now
